PERU TOUR AND TOURNAMENT 9 Days/8 Nights October 4-12, 2013

Day 1: Friday, October 4 – Lima

Individual arrivals today in Lima. Check into your executive floor ocean view room at the <u>JW Marriott Hotel</u> with its stunning central location and awe-inspiring architecture. Enjoy executive lounge access with complimentary food, daily wine tasting and other special amenities. The rest of the day is free to relax.

Day 2: Saturday, October 5 – Lima (B,D)



In the morning, our city tour starts with a visit to <u>Huaca Pucllana</u>, an adobe pyramid structure in the heart of the seaside district of Miraflores. We take a short walk through the historic center following Paseo de la República, taking in the colonial architecture of the Plaza San Martin and the Plaza de Armas, with grand buildings like the Government Palace, the Cathedral (housing the tomb of Pizarro) the Archbishop's Palace, and the Municipal Palace. Next, we visit the <u>Convent and Church of San Francisco</u>, which hold the oldest collection of colonial art in the Americas with paintings by Zurbarán and Rivera. The grand courtyard of the main cloister is decorated floor-to-ceiling in blue

and white Sevillian tiles which date back to the 16th century. Moroccan arches lead us to the Catacombs, a subterranean crypt from the colonial period where the bones of 25,000 colonial-era Lima residents are entombed. This evening join the group for our welcome dinner at the Restaurant "Pampa de Amancaes".

Day 3: Sunday, October 6, - Lima (B)

After breakfast, the day is free to explore the city on your own. In the afternoon, the Scrabble® tournament begins.

Day 4: Monday, October 7 – Lima to Sacred Valley (B)

This morning, we transfer to the airport and fly to Cusco. We then drive to the Sacred Valley where we check in to the beautiful <u>Hotel Aranwa Valle</u> in Urubamba. The hotel is on the site of a 17th century colonial hacienda that has been restored to its former grandeur. The afternoon is free to relax and enjoy the beautiful grounds.

Day 5: Tuesday, October 8 – Sacred Valley (B)

This morning, we head to the small town of <u>Pisac</u> where you will have free time to stroll through the famous Pisac Market, or visit the Pisac Incan ruins. After time for lunch, we return to our hotel.

Scrabble® tournament continues in the afternoon.



Day 6: Wednesday, October 9 – Sacred Valley – Machu Picchu – Cusco (B)



This morning, we take the <u>Vistadome</u> train with its large panoramic windows, which offer incomparable scenic views on the route to Machu Picchu. Our detailed guided tour will cover the main features of one of the "Seven New Wonders of the World." You will also have some free time to walk around the complex at your own pace. We take a late-afternoon Vistadome train for a scenic ride to Cusco. Snacks and entertainment are provided on both Vistadome train segments.

Check in to the <u>Libertador Palacio Del Inka</u>, which was built on the site of an ancient palace of the Inca Empire in the style of a colonial convent.

Day 7: Thursday, October 10 – Cusco (B)

In the morning our city tour will explore the history of the Incan culture and the vast changes that took place with the Spanish conquest. We'll



visit the main plaza, the Cathedral and the Temple of the Sun or <u>Koricancha</u>. We then visit the ruins on the outskirts of the city, stopping at the Inca ritual site of <u>Qenqo</u>, the water temple of <u>Tambomachay</u>, the customs house of <u>Puca Pucara</u> and the impressive Fortress of <u>Sacsayhuaman</u>, built strategically on the hill above city of Cusco. Afternoon is free

Day 8: Friday, October 11 - Cusco (B, D)

After breakfast, we will head to the <u>The Maras salt pans</u>, a stunning ancient patchwork of terraced pools filled with mineral-rich water that cascades down the side of the Qaqawiñay mountain. The local inhabitants have tended the Maras salterns for centuries, producing salt by evaporation.



From Maras it is a short drive to Quechuyuc Muyu, the central Inca terraced



monument of Moray. Inca civil engineers constructed the geometric landscape masterpiece from giant natural sink holes during the 15th and early 16th centuries. Covering 92 acres, the four terraced amphitheaters, known as Muyus, range from 130 feet to nearly 400 feet in diameter. The agricultural terraces were fed by a complex drip irrigation system, the remains of which are clearly visible today. Small holding reservoirs, hydraulic channels and carved stone

'pagcha" conduits controlled the flow of natural spring water to a precise trickle.

The Scrabble® tournament concludes in the afternoon. In the evening, say goodbye to new friends and old at our gala farewell dinner at the Restaurant "LIMO".

Day 9: Saturday, October 12 - Cusco (B)
