**SPACE IN THE MADNESS TOURNAMENT MAY BE LIMITED!** In order to make the tight schedule work optimally, each Madness division would have 20 players so that each player will play each opponent twice in a row with one KOH round at the end. We will initially open up ONE Madness division, and will then take a waitlist once we have 20 players. If we get at least 28 total players, we'll have 2 Madness division with the top division having 18-20 players and allowing unlimited play-ups (subject to size constraints), with the lower division(s) having 10-20 players. Depending on interest, there might only be one Madness division, so if you want to guarantee yourself a spot, please register and pay ASAP. Waitlisted players can register for the Mildness tournament, and will be moved over to the Madness event if space becomes available. Note: A Madness division with 14 players would play 40 rounds (triple RR + KOH). Any other number would play 39.

Possible Charter Bus from the National SCRABBLE® Championship in Buffalo, New York: The dates of the 2014 NSC are Saturday, August 9<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. Since the NSC will only be 400 miles away, I have opted to schedule the 2014 Madness/Mildness tournament so that those that are travelling to the NSC from far away can get some extra bang for their buck by playing in multiple tournaments while they are in the area. The charter bus will be feasible if we can get 30+ people, and the closer we get to 56, the cheaper it will be (i.e. if we have 30 people, the price will be \$100/person, but if we're close to 56, it will be much cheaper). The bus will feature an optional trip to Niagara Falls on Wednesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. We'll also have a fully rated 4 round "bus bird' tournament & will be showing *Word Wars* and/or *Scrabbylon* – see separate flyer for more info.

**Transportation:** Philadelphia is the nearest airport, although BWI is also an option.
